SPARC Modernization for Digital Transformation

Federal agencies today face several major IT challenges. By far the biggest challenge is that legacy infrastructure is consuming nearly **80% (\$64B)**, of the **\$80B federal IT budget** and leaving just **20% (\$16B)** available for IT modernization efforts. In 2019 they amounted to just **\$25M in additional funding** across all agencies.

Legacy SPARC environments **need to be replaced**. Agency CTOs have a choice to upgrade to SPARC M12 or retrofit with X86 infrastructure. By choosing **SPARC as-a-Service** agencies can reduce the total number of servers that need to be housed and powered, but there are many more benefits.
